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Diversity & Inclusion – a Comparison with Sports for a layman understanding

- 1. If you are an ARTISAN / SCULPTOR I can relate you to a Chess Player. You don't need a 'team' to complete your job and on your own you can easily deliver (the item) /win (the game).
- 2. Where you are Working as a Team to Produce or Deliver a Service I can relate your team as, a Cricket Team.
 - 1. You need a Wicket Keeper
 - 2. You need as many Batsmen as possible
 - 3. You need few best Fielders
 - 4. You need as many Bowlers as possible (Fast, Medium, Spin etc.)
- 3. This is called Diversity you need mixed talents/characters with this Differences and Similarities, you can achieve the Organizational Goal / Win the Match
- 4. Besides, after having mixed talents, will you manage only with Batsman? (who scored big runs)
- 5. You can't say that you don't need to involve Fielder/Bowler as you have scored big runs.
- 6. You may have to have Competent Bowler, Wicket Keeper and Fielders to restrict the opposite side and win the match.
- 7. This otherwise means Inclusion.
- 8. A Project or Task completion is like this. One needs to have mixed Talents/Characters (Diversity) and you must Involve all /Include all (Inclusion) to achieve the Objective.
